Note the aircraft in this coloring frame. They are T-6 Texans, which our pilots flew during advanced training. After this phase they were assigned to their bombers and fighters. This trainer has similar lines to the P-47 fighter used to escort our WWII bombers to their targets. The 56th Fighter Group flew these fighter aircraft (there is a picture of a P-47 in the *News Bites* section of this *Herald*, page. 14. Can you find it?). A total of five fighter groups belonged to the 2nd Air Division along with 14 bomber groups.

*Coloring hint: training aircraft were usually painted yellow.*
